

Apprenticeship Training Scheme

As per the Apprenticeship Act 1961, apprenticeship training is being imparted in 259 Establishments and 7441 apprentices are undergoing training. The Central Government has amended the Act, which is establishment friendly. The establishments may engage 2.5% to 15 % of total manpower as apprentice. Apprenticeship registration shall be done in DGT website: www.apprenticeshipindia.org and shall provide training as per Apprentices Act. As per the Act all employers need to pay stipend to the Trade apprentices. From Rs.6000/-pm to Rs.7000/-pm. To support Apprenticeship training, Government of India has introduced NAPS (National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme) with effect from dated: 19-08-2016 which is reimbursing 25% of stipend or Maximum of Rs.1500/- per month per apprentice to establishments. In addition Government of Karnataka has also introduced a scheme KATS (Karnataka Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme) under which additional reimbursement of Rs.1500/- per month per apprentice to Establishments; this reimbursement is for the year 2021-22.
