

CENTRALLY FUNDED PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION IN THE DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRIAL TRAINING AND EMPLOYMENT AT GLANCE

World Bank Assisted - Skills Strengthening for Industrial Value Enhancement (STRIVE)

Skills Strengthening for Industrial Value Enhancement (STRIVE) project is a World Bank assisted - Government of India program with the objective of improving the relevance and efficiency of skills training provided through ITIs and apprenticeships.

Project period : 5 years

Project closing date : Nov 2022

Funding pattern : 100% Central share

STRIVE falls under the Program for Results (P4R) based category of World Bank that ensures outcome driven funding i.e. disbursement from the World Bank would be based on achievement of Disbursement Linked Indicators (DLIs).

Result Area wise details of the program are provided below:

- (1) **Improved Performance of ITIs** : The institutions are required to complete self rating process on the MIS-NCVT portal and Govt. ITIs with grading of 2 and above are eligible to fill the Institute Strategic Plan(ISP). Based on the ISP submitted, ITIs will be shortlisted by the DGT for funding. Under this component, 22 ITIs (21 Government ITIs & 1 Private ITI) from the State are covered in a phased manner. Total project cost for this result area is Rs3257.25lakhs.
- (2) **Increased State Capacities to Support ITIs and Apprenticeship Training** : Under this result area, state governments will be incentivized for policy and regulatory reforms that are aimed at improving the overall environment for ITIs and apprenticeship. Total Project cost under this result area is Rs1750lakhs.
- (3) **Improved Teaching and Learning** : This result area covers activities that would complement the institutional reforms in vocational training under DGT.
- (4) **Improved and Broadened Apprenticeship Training** : The project aims to encourage Small and Medium Enterprises(SMEs), to engage in Apprenticeship Training through the involvement of business associations / industry clusters (ICs). Under this result area, the Industry Apprenticeship Initiatives will strengthen the capacity of ICs to promote apprenticeship within its member firms and to assist in managing the entire gamut of the apprenticeship process right from Identification of trainees to assessment, certification and final job placement of trainees. Under this result area 4 Industry clusters from the State have been selected with a total project cost of Rs400lakhs.

**UPGRADATION OF EXISTING GOVERNMENT INDUSTRIAL TRAINING INSTITUTE INTO MODEL ITI –
CENTRALLY SPONSORED SCHEME**

Objective of Model ITI:

- Key objective is to develop a benchmark for industry oriented ITI which would serve as a model for other ITIs and would also raise dignity of ITI education.
- Becoming a demand center for local industries for its expertise and best performance in training.
- Better engagement with local industries.
- Optimum utilization of capacity by running in shifts
- Training of unorganized sector workers.
- Industries get existing workforce trained in these Model ITIs.
- Other ITIs in the State will also be able to emulate the initiatives taken at the Model ITIs.

Design & Scope:

- Offer training to job entrants, existing workers and workers of unorganized sector through existing trades (upgraded to match the standards laid down), new trades and short-term training programs with customized skill training
- Sign flexi Memorandum of Agreement with industries
- Strengthening placement cell.

Constitution of IMC Society

- Institution Management Committee (IMC) society is formed in the pattern of scheme for 'Upgradation of 1396 Govt. ITIs through PPP'.
- State to review composition and working of IMC and if required overhaul IMC so that major trades are covered by the representatives of industry in IMC.
- **Funding Pattern: CS:SS= 70:30**

Year of implementation : 2015-16

Project Cost: Rs.10crores

Government ITI(M) Hosur Road is among the oldest ITIs established in the State. It was established in the year **1952**. A total of **25 trades** are implemented in this ITI including Center of Excellence- Electrical Sector with an annual intake capacity of **1835 trainees**. Besides having Advanced Vocational Training Scheme and Motor Driving Training School, the institute is catering to training in third shift to socially disadvantaged people and also providing Modular Employable Skills.

Located at a stone's throw away from the major industrial hub i.e., Electronics City and IT corridor, it is ideal to take up Automobile and Electrical sector and develop this ITI as a Model ITI.

- Model ITI- Government ITI Hosur Road(M) has obtained ISO 29990:2010 certificate.
- DGT, New Delhi has extended project period upto March-2022.

Name of the ITI : Government ITI Honnavar

Year of implementation : 2017-18

Project cost : Rs5crores.

- Central Share of Rs175lakhs has been released to State during Dec-2018.
- Total of Rs223lakhs including State and Central Share has been released to Government ITI Honnavar till date for Upgradation activities under Model ITI scheme.
